Cold Process Soap Making Equipment List

(Ideal for making 5 pound batches of soap)

Safety Items

- Eye Goggles
- Rubber Gloves
- Long sleeve shirt
- Long pants
- Socks and closed toed shoes
- Vinegar (if lye gets on skin, flush area with vinegar, then wash well with soap and water until the slippery feeling disappears)
- Fire Extinguisher
- Dust mask (optional)

Equipment (should be made of lye-resistant material)

- 1 12-quart Stainless Steel Stock Pot or other Mixing Container (i.e. heavy duty plastic mixing bowl, unchipped enamel pot, etc.)
- 1 Heatproof Container that holds at least 8 cups (i.e. glass measuring cup)
- Long Handled Stirring Utensils (i.e. stainless steel spoon or hard rubber spatula)
- Measuring Spoons
- 2 Accurate Thermometers made of glass or stainless steel
- Accurate Scale—preferably digital in ounces or grams, weighing up to 5 lb
- Soap Molds
- Timer (or a clock with a second hand)
- Pot Holders or Oven Mitts
- Old Towels
- Knife—sharp and un-serrated
- Cutting Board
- Stainless Steel Ladle
- Stainless Steel Wire Whisk (optional)
